Thank you for your interest in War Child, an international relief and development agency dedicated to providing immediate, effective and sustainable aid to some of the most vulnerable children caught up in conflict around the world.

War Child Australia is a national office of War Child UK. War Child Australia's role is to promote awareness of War Child and its work throughout the world, and to raise funds for War Child field projects. War Child Australia is entirely run by volunteers.

War Child UK undertakes field work in many locations throughout the world, in conjunction with local communities. The policy of working with local people wherever possible means that War Child employs fewer foreign aid workers than many other aid agencies or charities. If you are interested in working for War Child, check the site periodically and follow the application processes described if you are interested in and qualified for an advertised position.
