STATE COORDINATORS – NT, SA, TAS

As a State Coordinator with War Child Australia, you will be responsible for answering email queries from members of the public, including :

- questions about War Child's work and current projects
- requests for support with fundraising initiatives
- requests for speakers at schools or events, and more.

You will maintain a list of email addresses of supporters in your area, and periodically email them updates about War Child's work.

Building and maintaining relationships is integral to War Child Australia's work. We do not carry public liability insurance, and therefore cannot put on events. We rely on individuals and organisations to put on events in support of War Child.

From time to time you might attend or speak at events raising funds for War Child's work.

There will also be opportunities to become involved in other aspects of War Child Australia's work.

Requirements:

- Good oral and written communication skills
- Willingness to obtain a Working with Children Check ("blue card") (Queensland), police check, or your state's equivalent if your role will bring you into significant contact with children or young people.
